

The presentation about traffic safety – “Lessons that mean life“

The presentation consists of important traffic rules for all participants in traffic – pedestrians, cyclists and drivers. It emphasises the importance of behaving properly in traffic – not to run, use mobile phone, and other. Safe behaviors are presented by the green pedestrian and unsafe behaviors are presented by the red pedestrian.

Slide 1 - “Lessons that mean life“

Slide 2 – pedestrians use the sidewalk, vehicles use the roadway and the cyclists use the cyclists' lanes.

Slide 3 – Do not run, stop unexpectedly, read, play or talk on the phone

Slide 4 – It is especially dangerous to run outside the pedestrian crossing or to move sideling along the pedestrian crossing.

Slide 5 – You should stop, look left and right, listen, think, decide and then go.

Slide 6 - Safely crossing the street on the pedestrian crossing

Slide 7 – Even when the light is green for pedestrian, the vehicles that turn might be dangerous.

Slide 8 - When the green light for pedestrians appears, observe carefully the moving vehicles.

Slide 9 – It is dangerous to come of the sidewalk without paying attention.

Slide 10 – Pedestrians should avoid obstacles by moving far from the roadway.

Slide 11 – It is dangerous to move in the same course as vehicles.

Slide 12 – When there is no sidewalk, pedestrians move next to the roadway.

Slide 13 – If the pedestrians can't move next to the roadway, they should move in the opposite course from the vehicles to be able to spot them.
